

The University of Texas System Office of the Director of Police is seeking a Director to provide leadership, advice, and counsel to the police chiefs and senior leaders at each of the UT System's 15 academic and health institutions and to serve as oversight control for System-wide law enforcement activities as required by the Texas Education Code.

The University of Texas System Office of the Director of Police (ODOP) is charged with the responsibility of protecting the life and property of individuals who comprise the student body, faculty, and staff of the University of Texas System community.

Essential Functions: Provides guidance and supervision to the 14 police chiefs of the University of Texas System. Develops and administers law enforcement policies and procedures to enhance the safety of the approximately 269,000 faculty, staff, and students populating the UT System and its countless visitors. Designs, executes and monitors effectiveness of internal controls which provide reasonable assurance that operations are efficient, assets are safeguarded, financial information is reliable and applicable laws, regulations, policies and procedures are followed. Provides advice and counsel to chiefs of police and executive officers regarding law enforcement issues. Manages police operational inspections of 14 campus police departments. Conducts training and provides managerial assistance. Administers and coordinates the operations of the UT System Police Academy. Monitors case law and new legislation and updates police departments on legal issues. Oversees major criminal and internal affairs investigations.

Interested individuals must have a bachelor's degree in criminal justice or related field and a minimum of 10 years of law enforcement experience, including 5 years at the management level. Advanced Police Officer Certification by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Education is required within six months of hire date. A current Texas Class "C" Operator's Driver's License is required. A driving record check will be conducted.
